- Built on the ancient city of Neopolis, the cities population doubled in 1922 when the Greeks from Asia minor made there way here during the exchange of populations.

At a distance of just 165km from Thessaloniki, it is easy to reach by car, plane and ship, which makes it an ideal holiday destination. There are excellent road connections with all the large towns in the region. The international airport (at a distance of 30 km from the city), links Kavala to Athens by daily scheduled flights as well as to foreign countries by charter flights. The port connects Kavala and Thassos as well as other islands in the Aegean Sea by ship and ferry.

- The hospitable population and Unique natural beauty of the country of Kavala promise an ideal combination of business activity and recreation.

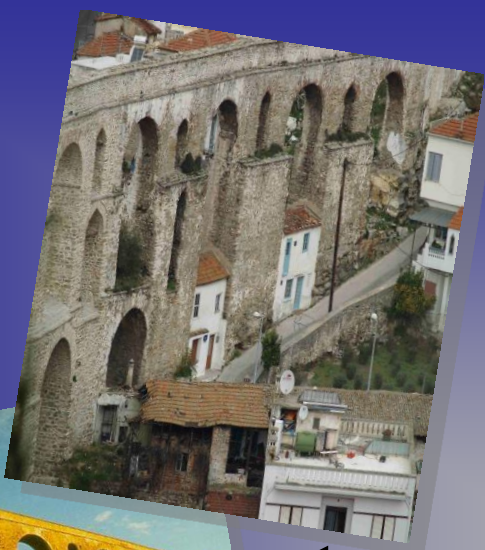




Other interesting places

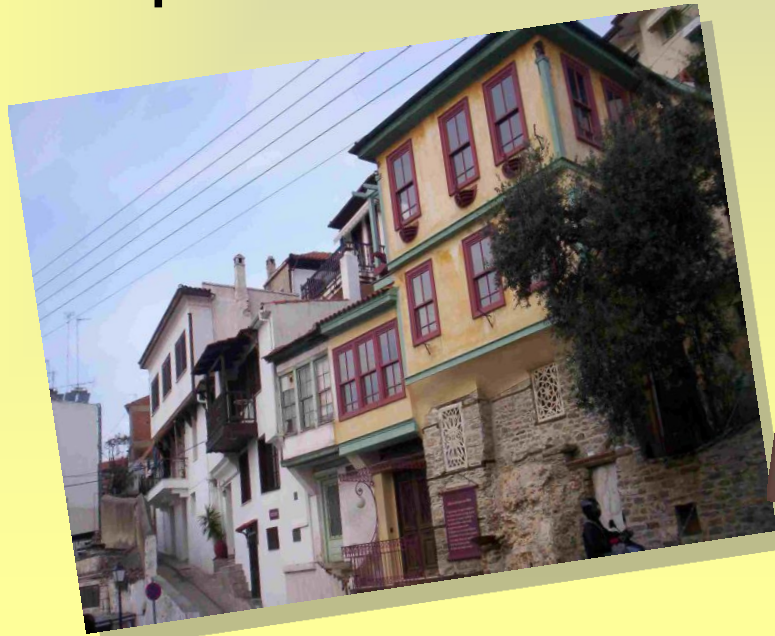

Where to stay and where u can eat?


- There are many places to stay, as there are in any city including government run and private campsites. There are hotels of every category. Restaurants are excellent and plentiful.
